

By 2020 there will be a £229m per year gap in the budget of health services across Dorset. The STP aims to reduce this by preventing people getting ill and using resources more efficiently.



Dorset has particular challenges, including a rising ageing population, unhealthy lifestyles, and running health services in rural areas.



There are currently 97 GP practices in Dorset, the STP is looking to reduce these and group them into bigger community hubs.



The STP could see specialist services and maternity units being radically changed. It must be more than a cost-cutting exercise.
